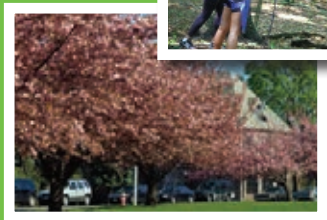

For more than 80 years, ANDRUS has been a proud provider of programs and services for children and families throughout Westchester County and the tri-state area. Every year, we reach over 2,500 children and families with a range of restorative services

ANDRUS began in 1928 as the Andrus Children's Home, founded by John Emory Andrus in memory of his wife, Julia Bourne Dyckman, who was orphaned as a young child. In creating his memorial to Julia, John Andrus invested in beautifying the grounds and building magnificent Tudor mansions as residences so the children. His legacy of attention to quality, safety and nurturing care has continuously shaped our work.



The orphanages of yesterday have been replaced by family and community-centered services, but we remain true to John Andrus' vision that every child deserves the best opportunity for a safe and fulfilling life.

What We Do



Campus Programs

Our Campus Residential Treatment Program helps children and families build brighter futures by providing a safe environment where children can learn to manage their emotions and understand and deal with loss.



Community Services

We have expanded our Community Services through partnerships with other organizations, including early childhood centers, public schools, homeless housing programs and mental health clinics.
